Emergency Transport of Injured Worker

- First aid attendant attends to injured worker
 - First aid attendant determines if patient can be moved to first aid room
- Emergency Responders are contacted as required Police, Fire, and Ambulance
 - Designate a person to meet the emergency crews and lead them to scene
- Should the ambulance be unavailable and transport of the injured person is required the following procedure shall be followed
 - The supervisor or shift foreman/charge hand will obtain the most suitable transport vehicle and will be the designated driver
 - In the event the supervisor foreman/charge hand is also first aid attendant then a driver shall be designated by the supervisor foreman/charge hand
- The driver shall proceed with all due prudence to the nearest medical aid facility or arranged location to meet the ambulance
 - The first aid attendant and any requested additional travel aid personnel shall concentrate upon the patient
 - A member of the transport team should attempt to contact the destination medical facility by phone to advise of the incoming patient and the situation
