

Emergency Procedure: Fire

AgSafe Safe Work Procedure

1. Call 9-1-1
2. Activate all alarms systems
3. Without incurring risk ensure that all persons, workers and patrons on premises are to be immediately notified of fire through any and all means available:
 - a. Microphones
 - b. Radios
 - c. Cell phones
4. Staff must report to Muster Station

Muster Station:

1. If a safe and effective plan to release livestock from pens to enable escape from the facilities will be undertaken. **This plan must be based upon the nature and size of the fire must have a primary consideration for human life and safety.**

This plan will require:

1. Communicated pairings of persons to effect release of animals.
2. Establishment of warning measures without risk to persons on highway and roadways adjacent for the purpose of preventing vehicular collision from uncontained, unrestrained animals freed from fire now at large.
3. An effort should be made if safe to move them to the gated rear of the adjacent veterinary facility as this would effectively contain the livestock without risk to persons or property.
4. Call out of persons to round up or contain released livestock should be activated at earliest opportunity.
5. This plan is part of an employee orientation and drills to effect evacuation are to be conducted annually and recorded.
