Extension Ladders

AgSafe Safe Work Procedure

- 1. All ladders must be either C.S.A. or ANSI approved.
- 2. Do not use ladders that appear unsafe, have broken or missing rungs or cracked side rails or damaged hardware.
- 3. All portable ladders must have non-slip shoes and they must be in the proper position.
- 4. Do not paint wooden ladders because the paint may hide cracks or other defects.
- 5. All ladders shall extend not more that 300mm (36") above landings.
- 6. Place ladders on a firm footing that is no further out from the wall than onequarter of the length of the ladder.
- 7. Ladders must be tied, blocked, or otherwise secured from slipping sideways.
- 8. If you must tie the ladder off ensure that there is someone there to hold the ladder in place while you climb up to tie it off.
- 9. Protect ladders used in locations like doorways, passageways from being bumped or knocked over.
- 10. When climbing face the ladder and use both hands.
- 11. Do not reach out from the ladder more than one arm length.
- 12. Do not use the top two rungs of the ladder.
