

# Silage & Forage Wagons

## AgSafe Safe Work Procedure

1. Ensure tires are of the type and size for the wagon and the load
2. Inspect tires prior to use
3. Never equip a wagon with implement tires if it will be towed by a truck at higher speeds
4. Ensure tractor is of sufficient power and weight with adequate braking and traction to control the maximum load of the wagon
5. Draw pins must be of proper size and material
6. Lock draw pin to prevent uncoupling
7. Keep hands and fingers clear of the pinch points while connecting the tongue to the drawbar
8. The PTO must be disengaged and the power shut off before unclogging or working on the wagon in any way
9. Never enter a self-loading wagon when it is operating
10. Dump wagons must have blocks under elevated parts prior to any maintenance occurring
11. Falls from load, drawbar or wagon are the leading cause of wagon related injuries and incidents
12. Remove any loose clothing or ring when working around these implements
13. Never allow extra riders
14. Avoid all ditches and steep banks
15. Avoid low trees and power lines
16. Inspect steering and wheel bearings prior to use of the wagon
