

Emergency in tub of Feed Mixer or Truck

- Heart attack
- Cramping
- Seizure
- Dehydration
- Slips
- Trips
- Falls
- Cuts from tools or string knife

Rescue Considerations

While there are many possibilities and occasions where injuries may occur no matter the task when working in agriculture, upon a farm or ranch, some special emergency response challenges are involved in this work and require consideration. Of note, air ambulance is available in the province for rural and remote locations.

Available extrication devices required on site by first aid assessment and supporting regulations will include (if required):

Spine board, rescue basket for use by trained and qualified persons, though not require by assessment or regulation at all sites, many producers have such a device or the ability to improvise in life over limb assessment.

Ability of monitoring, stand by, check in person to contact additional resources for help and provide adequate direction to site. Ensure this person has:

- AgSafe emergency direction sheet completed (posted or available)
- Phone numbers for first responders where 9-1-1 does not exist
- Ability to direct first aid and first responders to site
- Ability as a first aid attendant or ability to assist attendant
- Ability, means and knowledge to enter tub to perform first aid
